Guideline for sponsoring new Iron Dogs

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- 1. Use one application per person. If a couple is being sponsored each person needs their own application and if selected will be inducted separately.
- 2. Candidates must have a minimum of 20 years involvement in snowmobiling to qualify to become an Iron Dog.
- 3. Was the candidate truly active for the minimum of twenty (20) years or were there interruptions?
- 4. How well do you personally know the candidate you are sponsoring? How do his/her accomplishments rank with other IDB members? Do others share your views?
- 5. Are you reasonably sure the candidate will make an attempt to attend the next scheduled induction and remain active in the Iron Dog Brigade?
- 6. The sponsor <u>must</u> submit a letter of support in a written recommendation, <u>this is your chance to promote your candidate</u>, when you submit the application for membership.
- 7. At <u>least two</u> letters of recommendation from responsible sources must be attached to this completed application. (Candidate's colleagues or family)
- 8. Completed application must be returned by March 1st to the Iron Dog Secretary.

- 9. The application <u>must be</u> signed by the sponsor and applicant prior to submission.
- 10. The sponsor is responsible for ensuring the application is complete prior to submitting. The sponsor must feel comfortable with the accuracy of his/her achievements listed on the application. If not, it is the duty of the sponsor to verify such statements as to their truthfulness.
- 11. Following review of all applicants, the Board of Directors will send formal notification to you and your applicant along with a schedule for the induction ceremonies held at the next International Snowmobile Congress in early June.
- 12. If any of the above guidelines are not followed, the Iron Dog Board of Directors have the right to disqualify the candidate.
